At the public hearing, anyone may present data, make a statement, comment or offer a viewpoint or argument whether orally or in writing. Lengthy statements or statements of a considerable technical or economic nature, as well as previously recorded messages, must be submitted for the official record. Oral statements should be concise and will be limited to 5 minutes per person. Additional comments should be presented in writing. Written comments are welcome. To ensure their consideration, written comments must be received prior to May 26, 2017. The proposed rule amendments will be considered by the Georgia State Board of Dentistry at its meeting scheduled to begin at 10:05 AM on June 2, 2017 at the Department of Community Health at 2 Peachtree Street NW, Atlanta, Georgia, 30303. According to the Department of Law, State of Georgia, the Georgia State Board of Dentistry has the authority to adopt the proposed rule amendments pursuant to authority contained in O.C.G.A §§ 43-11-7.

At its meeting on March 3, 2017, the Board voted that the formulation and adoption of these amendments do not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the proposed amendments cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of O.C.G.A §§ 43-11-7, 43-11-9. At its meeting on 3/3/2017, the Board also voted that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of O.C.G.A §§43-11-7, 43-11-9 to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed at O.C.G.A § 50-13-4(a)(3)(A), (B), (C) and (D). The formulation and adoption of these amendments will impact every licensee in the same manner, and each licensee is independently licensed, owned and operated and dominant in the field of dentistry.

All complaints must be made in writing to the Georgia Board of Dentistry. Unless otherwise ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction or pursuant to a vote of the Board consistent with applicable state and federal law, neither the Board nor any of its members or administrative staff shall divulge the source from which information is received that relates to an actual or alleged infraction of the dental or dental hygiene laws.
