Open Session

The Injectable Pharmacologics Committee of the Georgia Board of Dentistry met on Friday, November 30, 2012. The meeting was called into open session at 9:09 a.m.

Approval of Minutes

Dr. Nalley made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 19, 2012 Injectable Pharmacologics Committee Meeting. Dr. Holcomb seconded and the Committee voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

Course Approval Discussion

The Committee discussed additional information provided by Drs. Maloney & Rudderman. The Committee recommended tabling this application until additional information has been received.

The Committee discussed the CE provider application that had been submitted for Ageless Aesthetic Institute. A motion was made by Dr. Nalley to deny the application. Dr. Godfrey seconded and the Committee voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

The Committee discussed the CE provider application that had been submitted for Aesthetic Advancements, Inc. A motion was made by Dr. Nalley to deny the application. Dr. Holcomb seconded and the Committee voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

Discussion was held by the Committee in regards to establishing guidelines when it comes to reviewing CE provider applications. Dr. Nalley stated that the Committee is looking for courses that are geared primarily towards dentists and taught by dentists. Dr. Holcomb stated that the Committee needs to develop a list of guidelines that will serve future members of the Committee. The main focus of the program needs to be geared towards the applications available in dentistry and should have a significant anatomical component. Dr. Bennett agreed and asked the Committee members to come up with some ideas and this would be discussed at the next meeting. The Committee members agreed to schedule a meeting on December 7, 2012 at 8:45 a.m.

Miscellaneous

Dr. Bennett asked if the Committee would be willing to move towards staff administratively approving applications for the administration of injectable pharmacologics. Dr. Holcomb responded by stating that he thinks the committee should wait until after the next legislative session. The Committee agreed.
