The Georgia Board of Dentistry Minutes September 12, 2003

A meeting of the Georgia Board of Dentistry was held on Friday, September 12, 2003 at the Professional Licensing Boards Office, 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia.

Dr. Nalley, Board President, established that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order at 9:11 a.m. Dr. Cook made a motion to accept the minutes for the August 15, 2003 conference call. Dr. Walker seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Conscious Sedation/General Anesthesia Committee

Dr. Walker made a motion to approve a \$100 fee for evaluation of additional sites. Dr. Trager seconded the motion. Drs. McFarland and Carroll opposed the motion. The motion carried by a vote of 7 to 2.

Discussion ensued about the use of halcion and other single agents for sedation. Dr. Trager made a motion to refer the matter to the Attorney General's Office for clarification. Dr. Walker seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Credentialing Committee

Dr. Trager announced that the Credentialing Committee would be meeting after the full Board meeting.

Dental Hygiene Sub-Committee

Ms. Anday, RDH made a motion to request clarification from the Attorney General's Office regarding the voting rights of the dental hygiene and consumer members of the Board. Dr. Wolff seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Examination Committee

Dr. McFarland asked for volunteers for the 2004 SRTA exams. He stated that he would send printed schedules to Board members once it is complete. Dr. Walker announced that Dr. Peter Trager was recognized for outstanding service for the Constitution and By-Laws Committee and Dr. Chris McFarland was recognized for outstanding service for the SRTA Exam Committee.

Dr. Walker agreed to serve as Board representative for the December 1-2, 2003 National Board Examination at the Medical College of Georgia.

General

<u>Correspondence from ADA regarding Accreditation Site Visits</u> – Dr. Carroll agreed to participate in the visit at Central Georgia Technical College on November 20-21, 2003.

<u>Correspondence from MCG regarding offering residency positions and granting teaching</u> <u>licenses to foreign trained dentists</u> – The Board decided to send written correspondence referring to the law and rules.

<u>Correspondence from Angela Wheeler regarding expanded duties certificates from the US</u> <u>Navy</u> – Dr. Trager made a motion to approve with limitations set forth in Rule 150-9-.02. Dr. Walker seconded the motion. Dr. Nalley opposed. The motion carried.

Correspondence from Dentsply Pharmaceutical regarding Oraqix – The Board decided to send written correspondence referencing Rule 150-9-.01 and advising the company that because it is permissible for assistants to apply topical anesthetics, it is therefore allowable for dental hygienists.

<u>2004 Board Meeting Dates</u> – Dates were approved with a change to the February date.

Board Autonomy – A determination was made that the Ad-Hoc Committee on Board autonomy will pursue research on this issue and report back to the Board on its findings.

Legislative Committee

The Board agreed that the Credentialing committee will meet with the GDA in Macon on December 5, 2003 to discuss proposed credentialing legislation.

Rules Committee

Dr. Carroll made a motion to take no action on the issue regarding Rx phone-ins or renewals by agents of a licensed dentist. Dr. Trager seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Executive Director's Open Session

Ms. Thomas gave an operations and statistics report on applications received, licenses issued, and disciplinary cases opened. The upcoming renewal period was discussed and Dr. Walker suggested that the GDA, GDS, and the GDHA send reminders to its membership about the importance of notifying the Board of any address changes.

Attorney General's Open Session

Ms. Krause reported that no review of the final decision has been requested from Dr. Felix Sibley. She also gave an update on the OSAH Hearing regarding Dr. Mark Dravis.

Miscellaneous

The Board reviewed correspondence from Dr. Steven Hill regarding electronic records. A copy of the Board policy regarding electronic record keeping will be mailed to Dr. Hill.

Ms. Renee Graham of Valdosta Technical College presented information regarding CPR certification from the American Safety and Health Institute. Dr. Trager advised that this issue is on the Rules committee agenda for discussion immediately following the Board meeting.

The Board voted to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O. C. G. A. §43-1-2(k) and 43-1-19(h) to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications, investigative reports, and the Assistant Attorney General's report. Voting in favor of the motion were Ms. Anday, Dr. Andrews, Dr. Carroll, Dr. Cook, Mr. McDougald, Dr. McFarland, Dr. Nalley, Dr. Trager, Dr. Walker, and Dr. Wolff. The Board concluded executive session in order to vote on these matters and to continue with the public session.
